



Navimatics Releases “Charts&Tides+” for the iPhone

Kirkland, WA / Oct 1, 2009. Navimatics Corporation has released “Charts&Tides+” to the iPhone App Store; the software is currently pending Apple’s approval. “Charts&Tides+” is the latest incarnation of the company’s leading marine navigation software for the iPhone. The product’s major new feature is a complete 3D coastal relief model for the continental United States in addition to the other marine navigation features already present.

The new 3D coastal relief model is based on the NOAA Coastal Relief Model and it combines bathymetry and topography. It provides a 3 dimensional comprehensive view of the US coastal areas and allows users to explore what an unfamiliar area looks like from different angles, assess the shape of the ocean bottom and develop better situational awareness and confidence in one’s navigational plan.

“Charts&Tides+” incorporates marine chart data from NOAA Electronic Navigational Charts, bathymetric and topographic data from the NOAA Coastal Relief Model, tide harmonics data for real-time tide and current computation and access to NDBC weather stations for current weather conditions. The product uses the device’s built-in GPS (available in the iPhone 3G and 3GS) to provide location information and navigation guidance while on the water.

“Charts&Tides+” will be offered for 3 different US regions (West Coast, East Coast and Gulf Coast) and will retail for \$44.99.
